Arm and Disarm

Arm:

- To arm all sensors in **AWAY** mode when you are leaving the premises, enter your [security code] + [AWAY].
- To arm in **STAY** mode when you are not leaving the premises, enter your [security code] + [STAY].

Disarm:

- To disarm, enter your [security code] + [OFF].

Battery

- The Ademco 4110DL/4110XM operates on a **[Battery Replacement Page](#)**.

Bypass Protected Areas

Bypassing a zone allows you to arm your system with certain protected areas intentionally unarmed or to access a protected area when the system is armed.

- **To bypass a zone, enter your [security code] + [BYPASS] + [2-digit zone number].**
- **To unbyypass a zone, enter your [security code] + [OFF].**

Chimes and Beeps

When your system is in chime mode, a chime alert will sound three tones whenever a protected door/window is opened.

- **To turn the door chime function on and off, enter your [security code] + [CHIME].**
- **Toggle between On, to turn the chime feature on and Off, to turn the chime feature off.**

Reset

To clear the display after an alarm event, enter your [security code] + [OFF] twice.

Security Codes

Your system allows for additional users, however only the Master user can assign user codes to users.

- **To add a user, enter your [Master code] + [8] + [new user number] + [4-digit new user's code].**
- **To add a duress code, enter your [Master code] + [8] + [8] + [4-digit code]. * The duress code is to be used when a user is forced to arm or disarm the system against their will.**
- **To delete a user, enter your [Master code] +[8] + [user number]. Wait approximately three seconds for the keypad to verify.**

Trouble Conditions

Trouble conditions are indicated by the word CHECK and continual beeping from the touchpad. Any key will silence the beeping. A display of CHECK + zone no. may indicate that a problem requires your attention. Check the specified zone area, close any open doors or windows and enter your security code and press [OFF]. If your system includes wireless sensors, the CHECK condition may be caused by some change in the environment of the protected area.

To silence trouble beeps, press any key or enter your security code and press [OFF].
